Background Information:

The purpose of this joint meeting is to share information and update our elected officials on the current status of housing and homelessness in Tehama County. Presenters will share information on our current Housing Plan/Housing Element, data describing barriers to housing for homeless and very low income individuals, identified public safety implications, and a proposal of recommendations. This proposal is the product of work created by community stakeholders from across the county who have convened over the past nine months to analyze and prioritize solutions to issues of homelessness in Tehama County. The work of this group aligns with the Grand Jury request for action on this complex issue.

This joint informational session is a crucial component in the process of developing and endorsing a formalized plan to address issues of homelessness in our community.
