Special Note On Public Meetings During Shelter-In-Place Order: Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order N-29-20, a local legislative body is authorized to hold public meetings via teleconferencing and to make public meetings accessible telephonically or otherwise electronically to all members of the public seeking to attend and to address the local legislative body, during the period in which local public officials impose measures to promote social distancing.

Effective February 24, 2021 Groundwater Commission meetings will be opened to limited in-person attendance and will accommodate 35 members of the public on a first-come, first-served basis with the following safety measures in place:
