SPECIFICATIONS FOR LIQUID ASPHALT/ASPHALTIC EMUSSIONS

The bidder's Refinery shall have the ability to provide Liquid Asphalt and Asphaltic Emulsion for spreading on various roads or project sites within the County of Tehama within three (3) hours of manufacture. **Liquid Asphalt/Asphaltic Emulsions** shall conform to the provisions of the State of California, Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for the State of California, May 2006, Section 93 Liquid Asphalts and 94 Asphalt Emulsions.

The County reserves the right to test and inspect all orders prior to acceptance. The quantities on the "Bid Schedule" are approximate only and are shown as a basis for comparison of bids only. The County of Tehama does not, expressly or by implication, agree that the actual amount of the purchases will correspond therewith, but reserves the right to increase or decrease the amount as deemed necessary by the Director of Public Works.

Types of Liquid Asphalt/Asphaltic Emulsions for which bids are being solicited are MC-250, SC-800, CSS-1h CQS-1h, PMCRS-2h, and PMRE/Styra-Flex Rejuvenating Emulsion or equivalent.

The PMCRS-2h and PMRE materials will be purchased from the same supplier when used for a roadway double chip seal project to insure material consistency and compatibility.

The term of this bid shall be effective on the Board of Supervisor (Board) approval date through January 31, 2018, inclusive. All material price bids shall be effective on the Board approval date.

Each responsive bid will be placed on the County's approved bid list, ranked from lowest to highest. For each road repair and maintenance project during the term of this bid, the County will determine whether the lowest bidder on the bid list has the required material available at the time and in the quantities needed for the project. If so, then a sub-award will be made to that bidder at the bid price on the approved bid list. If the lowest bidder does not have the required material available, the County will repeat the process with the next lowest bidder on the approved bid list and thereon, until a sub-award is made to the lowest bidder on approved bid list that has the required material available. The County shall have no obligation to make any purchase from any bidder until a written sub-award is made by the Purchasing Agent or designee. Nothing in this Proposal shall be construed to require the County to purchase any asphalt material types from any bidder that are not included within this proposal under any circumstances.

Bids and bid price per ton shall be for furnishing, delivering and spreading Liquid Asphalts and Asphaltic Emulsions within Tehama County, including a two (2) hour spread time. Any additional time approved in advance by the County will be charged at the quoted price per hour.
