**AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CLOSE SAMSON AVENUE AND VENTURA AVENUE AT THE INTERSECTION OF EAST CHARD AVENUE FROM SEPTEMBER 18, 2017 TO OCTOBER 31, 2017 TO ACCOMMODATE THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES ELDER CREEK CHANNEL REHABILITATION PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, Streets and Highways Code section 942.5, subdivision (a & c) authorizes the Board of Supervisors to close any county highway whenever the Board considers such closing necessary for the protection of the public and during construction, improvement or maintenance operations thereon; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Water Resources will remove up to 100,000 cubic yards of material from Elder Creek and transport the material using the Gerber Levee System and cross Samson Avenue and Ventura Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, the movements of heavy machinery transporting material over these portions of the roadway presents a public safety concern and imminent roadway failure that would render them impassible and unsafe to meet local traffic needs during the project period, necessitating the need to close the Samson Avenue and Ventura Avenue Gerber Levee crossings near the intersection of East Chard Avenue.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to close Sampson Avenue and Ventura Avenue near the intersection of East Chard Avenue for the period of September 18, 2017 through October 31, 2017 to accommodate the Department of Water Resources Elder Creek Channel Rehabilitation Project.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Director of Public Works shall issue such public noticing as he deems necessary to properly notify the public, and shall install such temporary traffic signs as he deems necessary to close Sampson Avenue and Ventura Avenue near the intersection of East Chard Avenue
