A RESOLUTION OF THE TEHAMA COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION UNDER THE 2019 SUSTAINABLE GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT GRANT PROGRAM'S PLANNING GRANT- ROUND 3

WHEREAS, the Tehama County Flood Control and Water Conservation District was recognized as the Exclusive Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA) by the Department of Water Resources on February 11, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act of 2014 requires that the Department of Water Resources provide technical and financial assistance to local agencies for sustainable groundwater management; and

WHEREAS, the Sustainable Groundwater Planning Grant Program pursuant to the California Drought, Water, Parks, Climate, Coastal Protection, and Outdoor Access for All Act of 2018 (Prop 68) (Pub. Resources Code, Section 80000et seq) provides financial resources for the development and implementation of Groundwater Sustainability Plans

WHEREAS, grant funding is being made available to eligible Groundwater Sustainability Agencies (GSAs) on a competitive basis through the California Drought, Water, Parks, Climate, Coastal Protection, and Outdoor Access for All Act of 2018 (Prop 68); and

WHEREAS, the Tehama County Flood Control and Water Conservation District has been recognized the GSA for the portions of the Bowman, South Battle Creek, Bend, Red Bluff, Antelope, Corning, and Los Molinos Subbasins located within Tehama County; and

WHEREAS, the Red Bluff and Los Molinos Subbasins are designated as medium priority under SGMA; and

WHEREAS, the Antelope and Corning Subbasins are designated as high priority under SGMA; and

WHEREAS, as a GSA, the Tehama County Flood Control and Water Conservation District is currently working in collaboration with the other GSA entity in the Corning Subbasin to develop and implement the GSP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that an application be made to the California Department of Water Resources to obtain a grant under the 2019 Sustainable Groundwater Management (SGM) Grant Program Planning – Round 3 Grant pursuant the California Drought, Water, Parks, Climate, Coastal Protection, and Outdoor Access

for All Act of 2018 (Prop 68) (Pub. Resources Code, Section 80000et seq), and to enter into an agreement to receive a grant for the Groundwater Sustainability Plan Development for the Red Bluff, Antelope, and Los Molinos Subbasins.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Tehama County Flood Control and Water Conservation District Board of Directors hereby authorizes and directs the Flood Control/Water Resources Executive Director or Designee to prepare the necessary data, conduct investigations, and file a grant application with the California Department of Water Resources.
